

China Link Scholarship Program



● I. Program Introduction

In order to deepen the academic friendship and mutual understanding between Chinese and foreign young generation, and to build a platform for the international exchanges and cooperation of young talents, China Scholarship Council (CSC) has established the China Link Scholarship Program for international students and faculties hoping to engage in academic and research activities in China.

The China Link Scholarship is a pilot program initiated by the China Scholarship Council (CSC) in order to reinforce long-term research collaboration and two-way staff/student mobility between CSC's overseas university partners and Chinese universities (list of partner universities can be found via the links below), and it **can support full-time students, faculty, and academic staff from other countries to undertake a period of non-degree study.**

**UESTC is one of the Chinese Host Universities for this China-Link Scholarship Program.*

● II. Program Scheme

1 Funding Categories

General scholar: applicable to current undergraduates or master students.

Senior scholar: applicable to current PhD students or faculties

2 Duration

One (1) to twelve (12) months

Start study in China no later than August 31, 2025.

3 Working Language

English or Chinese, can freely and fluently communicate..

4 Study/Research Fields

All disciplines other than Chinese language study.

● III. Timeline of Scheme

There are four times for applicant to apply for this scholarship each year.

● IV. Funding

Successful applicants will receive a full scholarship from CSC during their stay in China, **including:**

- ★ Tuition fee (if applied)
- ★ free on-campus accommodation
- ★ comprehensive medical insurance
- ★ monthly stipend (CNY 3,000 for general scholars; CNY 3,500 for senior scholars)

● V. Eligibility

- ★ Be a citizen of a country other than the People's Republic of China
- ★ Be under 45 years of age when applying for general scholars; Be under 50 years of age when applying for senior scholars
- ★ Be registered as a full-time student or employed as a full-time academic staff at CSC's foreign partner universities by the time of application and throughout the proposed stay in China.
- ★ Have received either the admission notice or the invitation letter issued by the Chinese host university.

UESTC Short-Term Research Training Program



◎ I. Program Introduction

In order to carry out the Internationalization Strategy and to build a platform for young talents from our partner universities to communicate with each other, University of Electronic Science and Technology of China (UESTC) has established the Short-Term Research Training Program for international students hoping to engage in academic and research activities in UESTC which is a pilot program initiated by the university to reinforce long-term research collaboration and two-way student mobility between UESTC and its overseas partner universities.

◎ II. Program Scheme

1 Duration

3 months, from June to September, 2025

2 Language

English or Chinese, language requirements are the same as the visiting exchange students in UESTC

3 Study/Research Fields

- ★ Applicants shall contact a suitable supervisor or instructor who is willing to accept them as exchange students prior to applying online.

April 15, 2025

◎ IV. Funding

Successful applicants may receive the following scholarships during their stay in China.

Type one: Full Scholarship (only grant to excellent international students evaluated by UESTC's interview) **including:**

- ★ Tuition fee (waived)
- ★ free on-campus accommodation
- ★ comprehensive medical insurance
- ★ monthly stipend (CNY 3,000 for undergraduates or master students; CNY 3,500 for PhD students)

Type Two: Partial Scholarship (grant to applicants from our partner universities signed with Students Exchange Agreement) **including:**

- ★ Tuition fee (waived)
- ★ free on-campus accommodation

NOTE: Applicants may need to be self-funded if he or she can not be granted with the two types scholarships after our evaluation.

◎ V. Eligibility

- ★ Applicants must be non-Chinese citizens of sound health;
- ★ Be registered as a full-time undergraduate or graduate student at a UESTC's foreign partner university, and will pursue a Bachelor's or academic Master's/PhD degree;
